

ICE Award for Cudworth & West Green Bypass

At the recent Institution of Civil Engineers (ICE) Yorkshire and Humber awards ceremony, the VHE team received the Centenary Award Certificate of Excellence for their work on the £16 million Cudworth & West Green Bypass Project.

VHE collected the award along with the customer Barnsley Metropolitan Borough Council at the awards dinner on Friday 19th March 2011 at the National Railway Museum in York from ICE President, Peter Hansford. The judges said “We were impressed with the use of innovative new high strength, long life road base materials.” This referred to the novel use of EME2 as a binder course on the scheme which reduced the overall surfacing materials requirement by 10%.
